Professional Summary

Senior Software Engineer with 7+ years in B2B SaaS, 6 at Goava (Sweden), fully remote. Owner of the company-discovery core: 20+ multi-layered filters over 6.5M companies, D3.js analytics and map-based views, built for render performance at scale. Most recently built the front end for an AI prospecting agent, letting users configure targeting, budget, and schedule on top of a RAG and tool-calling backend.

- **AI agent configuration:** Built the configuration front end for an autonomous AI prospecting agent, letting sales teams define targeting, execution schedules, and token budget limits on top of a RAG and tool-calling backend.
- **Web Worker performance:** Moved sorting, filtering, and aggregation of 3,000+ real-time insight records off the main thread into Web Workers, reducing main-thread blocking and keeping infinite scroll smooth.
- **Partner embed:** Built a recommendation widget using Next.js on-demand ISR with edge caching, pre-rendering the top 3 similar companies via webhooks to serve sub-100ms loads inside external iframe dashboards.
- **State architecture:** Separated server domain data (Redux) from client UI state (React Context) across the app, removing global re-renders and making the codebase easier to work in.
- **Engineering standards:** Established a two-reviewer PR workflow and reviewed AI-assisted code for design pattern consistency, keeping the codebase from drifting architecturally.

Software Engineer (February 2020 – December 2023)

- **Multi-tier filtering:** Built geometry-driven cascading flyout filters and D3.js histogram controls over 6.5M+ companies, cutting redundant intermediate Elasticsearch queries by letting users target multiple tiers directly. This became the product's core discovery experience.
- **Geospatial analytics:** Implemented a multi-level interactive map (react-leaflet + D3.js domain scaling) with county-to-municipality drill-down, replacing a paid proprietary tile service with an open-source stack.
- **Codebase modernization:** Led the progressive migration from 2014-era class components and HOCs to functional components and custom hooks, improving modularity and shortening onboarding for new developers.
- **Bundle optimization:** Replaced monolithic dependencies with in-house modules

Frontend Tech Lead (Contract) (July 2024 – December 2024)

- **Blade to Next.js migration:** Led the front-end re-architecture of a flight booking engine, moving from monolithic Laravel Blade templates to a Next.js application.
- **Dual payment gateway integration:** Unified two gateways with incompatible redirect behaviour by building a server-side route interception layer in Next.js that normalizes bKash's external POST redirects and SSLCommerz's GET webhooks into a single payment status flow.
- **Booking state persistence:** Built a multi-step flight booking flow with redux-persist, preserving route and passenger data across refreshes and removing repeated API calls between steps.
- **Search and filtering:** Built flight discovery with time-of-day, cabin class, and layover filters, updating results without layout shift.
- **Team leadership:** Led a small front-end team, running architectural code reviews and setting front-end conventions for the codebase.
- **Development workflow:** Introduced separate dev and production environments and moved feature and bug tracking from spreadsheets to Trello, giving the team a clearer path from issue to release.
- **Deployment and infrastructure:** Provisioned and configured a VPS for the production booking site: nginx as a reverse proxy, PM2 for process management, DNS setup, plus deployments and day-to-day server upkeep.

Junior Software Engineer (February 2019 - January 2020)

- **Cart and checkout:** Built cart and checkout features in Vue.js and Vuex, including an auto-coupon evaluation step that applied eligible discounts automatically instead of requiring users to enter codes at checkout.
- **Category navigation:** Restructured the product catalog from a flat schema into an n-ary tree, letting users traverse multi-level nested categories without additional API calls per level.
- **Asset cleanup:** Built a utility that stripped redundant YAML files, unused objects, and dead attributes from the build, cutting initial page load time by around 7%.
- **Internal tooling:** Prototyped a self-hosted asset delivery service with Nuxt.js and Adonis.js to evaluate replacing third-party media storage (prototype, not shipped to production).
- **Delivery routing:** Built approximate route path mapping to reduce back-and-forth driving for delivery riders, with assignment heatmaps showing which zones carried the heaviest delivery load.
- **Blade to Nuxt.js migration:** Part of the team that moved the admin panel from monolithic Blade views to a separate SSR front end in Nuxt.js.
